



**MARYLAND CHILDREN'S HEALTH PROGRAM  
HEALTH CARE FOR CHILDREN AND PREGNANT WOMEN**



Welcome to the Maryland Children's Health Program (MCHP), a health insurance program for children up to age 19 and pregnant women. This program gives free and low cost health care to children and pregnant women in families with low to average incomes. Covered services include in-patient hospital care, medical doctor visits, lab tests, dental care, eye care, medicines and immunizations. Income before taxes and other deductions is counted.

**Free Coverage for Children**

Beginning July 1, 2004, the yearly qualifying income levels for children are:

\$18,620 for a family of 1	\$31,340 for a family of 3	\$44,060 for a family of 5
\$24,980 for a family of 2	\$37,700 for a family of 4	Add \$6,360 for each additional member

**Free Coverage for Pregnant Women**

Beginning July 1, 2004 the yearly qualifying income levels for pregnant women are:

\$31,225 for a family of 2*	\$39,175 for a family of 3	\$55,075 for a family of 5
*pregnant woman and unborn child	\$47,125 for a family of 4	Add \$7,950 for each additional member

**Low-Cost Coverage for Children**

If you are not eligible for free health care services through MCHP, your children may be eligible for MCHP *Premium*. You will pay a low monthly premium to purchase health coverage for your children. If you are interested in this program, answer "yes" to Question 6 on the application. The cost per family is \$41.00 - \$52.00 per month. This amount changes slightly each year. The yearly qualifying income levels beginning July 1, 2004 are:

\$27,930 for a family of 1	\$47,010 for a family of 3	\$66,090 for a family of 5
\$37,470 for a family of 2	\$56,550 for a family of 4	Add \$9,540 for each additional member

The qualifying income amount changes every year. **IMPORTANT:** Even if your income is a little higher than the amount shown for your family size, you and your children may still qualify if you work, pay for childcare, alimony or child support. Therefore, please apply.

Please take the time to fill out the application and mail or bring it to your local health department. A list of the local health departments is located on the last page of the application form. If you need help completing the application, or help in your language, please call your local health department.

We know how expensive health care can be. We are pleased that Maryland can offer this help to you as you continue to work to meet the health care needs of your family.

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**Important Information about Your MCHP Application**

After you fill out the MCHP application form, you may mail or bring it to the local health department in the county where you live (or to Baltimore Health Care Access, if you live in Baltimore City). The addresses and telephone numbers for the local health departments are on the last page of the application form.

When the local health department receives the application, a case manager will be assigned to determine eligibility for everyone applying for MCHP. The case manager will answer your questions about MCHP. The case manager may call or write to you to get additional information, if needed. The case manager will determine eligibility and send you a letter telling you the decision. **If you don't hear from your case manager or receive a decision letter about your eligibility within three weeks after the date you mailed or took your application form to the local health department, call the local health department and ask to speak to the MCHP Eligibility Unit.**

If you are eligible for MCHP, you will receive a red and white Medical Care Program card. You'll also receive information to choose a Managed Care Organization (MCO) participating in *HealthChoice*, Maryland Managed Care Program. **If you don't receive a Medical Care Program card and MCO enrollment information within 30 days of the date of your decision letter, call your case manager at the local health department.** If you are applying as a pregnant woman, abortion is not covered.

**If your family income is above the limit for MCHP, and you've answered "yes" to question 6 on the application form, your children may qualify for MCHP Premium.** If so, you'll receive information from the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene about MCHP Premium. You'll have a case manager at the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene who will work with you to enroll your children in MCHP Premium and explain how to obtain health care for your children.

It's important to keep your information current with your case manager. If you have a change in name, address, number of people in the household, income, employment or pregnancy, please call or write your case manager within 10 days of the change. Your case manager will let you know if the change affects your eligibility.
